2 ☐ Exodus 12:1-13

Background

- 70 become 2 million in 400 yrs.
- Enslaved by Egyptians
- God delivers through 10 Plagues
- #10 – Death of the Firstborn

3 ☐ Exodus 12:1-13

Purpose

- To judge the sin of Pharaoh
- To judge the sin of Egyptians (idolatry)
- To judge the gods of Egypt, polytheism

"I AM the Lord and there is no other"

4 ☐ Exodus 12:1-13

Protection for God's People

- Kill a lamb, roast & eat
- Put some blood on sides & top of doorframe
- When angel of death saw blood, he would "passover"

5 ☐ Exodus 12:1-13

What does this have to do with Jesus?

1Cor. 5:7 – "Christ is our Passover Lamb"

- Connection between Ex. 12 & Jesus

6 ☐ Ephesians 1:7

"In Jesus, we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance

with the riches of God's grace."

*In Jesus – by having faith in Jesus
redemption – avoiding God's judgment
through His blood – like in Ex. 12
forgiveness of sins – deliverance from sin*
