### **Day 1 - April 25 - Wednesday:**

#### **USA - Tel Aviv**

Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

### **Day 2 - April 26 - Thursday:**

#### **Tel Aviv**

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv. Meeting and assistance by Coral Travel & Tours representative inside the terminal. Transfer to your hotel in Tel-Aviv. Dinner and Overnight: Hotel in Tel-Aviv.

### **Day 3 - April 27 - Friday:**

#### **Caesarea - Megiddo - Sea of Galilee**

After breakfast travel through the Sharon plain to **Caesarea**, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. A drive up **Mt. Carmel** will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Continue to **Megiddo**, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built again by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon. On your way to the north pass **Nazareth** and stop at **Nazareth Ilit** while viewing the **Plains of Jezreel**. Continue through **Kfar Cana** to **Mt. Arbel**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

### **Day 4 - April 28 - Saturday:**

#### **Sea of Galilee**

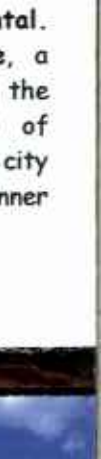
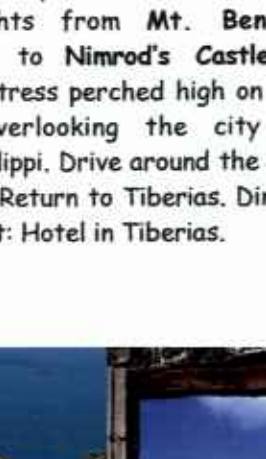
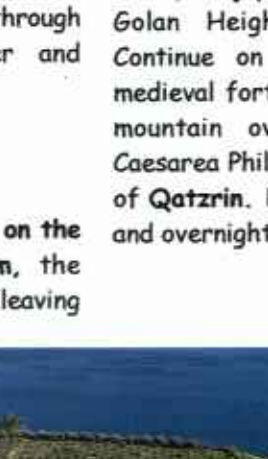
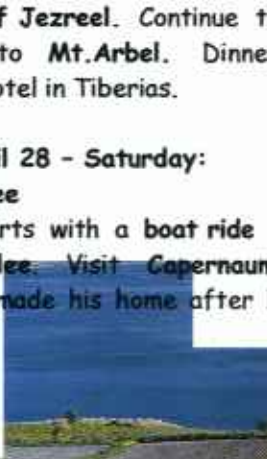
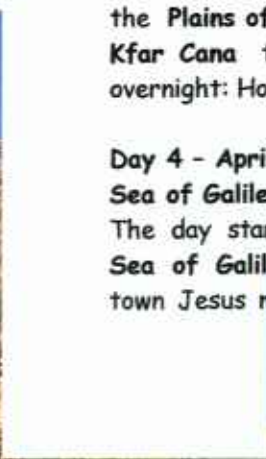
The day starts with a boat ride on the **Sea of Galilee**. Visit **Capernaum**, the town Jesus made his home after leaving

**Nazareth**. **Capernaum** is the place where Jesus recruited the first of His disciples (Matthew 4:13, Luke 4:31-37, Matthew 8:14-17, Mark 2:1-12, Matthew 8:5-13, Mark 5:21-43, Matthew 11:23-24). Visit the excavation of the ancient synagogue and the house of St. Peter. Continue to the "ancient boat" believed to be from Jesus time at **Kibbutz Ginosar**. Visit the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-12). For lunch we'll have the opportunity to sample the St. Peter Fish (on our own). Visit the newly dug site of **Bethsaida**, which, according to some scripture, is the site of the feeding of the 5000. Continue on to **Kursi**, the site of the miracle with the swine. We'll end the day at the **Jordan River** with an opportunity to be baptized (optional). Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

### **Day 5 - April 29 - Sun.:**

#### **Golan Heights**

After breakfast drive to **Tel Dan** an important biblical city and a breathtaking nature reserve. The bible mentions the city few times: "From Dan to Beer Sheba". Continue to the **Banias**, site of the ancient **Caesarea Philippi**. It is here that Peter made his confession of faith in Jesus (Matthew 16:13). Enjoy a panoramic view of the Golan Heights from **Mt. Bental**. Continue on to **Nimrod's Castle**, a medieval fortress perched high on the mountain overlooking the city of **Caesarea Philippi**. Drive around the city of **Qatzrin**. Return to Tiberias. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.



**Day 6 - April 30 - Monday:**

**Bet She'an - Jericho - Dead Sea**

After breakfast leave Tiberias and drive to **Bet She'an**. Recent excavations have unveiled the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 AD. Continue on to the **Star of the Valley**, a crusader fortress in excellent condition overlooking the Jordan Valley. Visit **Ein Harod - Gideon Springs**. Drive through the **Jordan Valley** and stop at the **War Monument of the Jordan Valley** (at the Junction of Ma'ale Ephraim) overlooking the **Gilgal** the crossing point of the Israelites to the **Promised Land**. Continue along the Jordan Valley past **Jericho**, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt -and the walls fell down'- and was also the site of the **Mt. of Temptation**. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to your hotel. Enjoy an afternoon "float" at the **Dead Sea**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel at the Dead Sea

**Day 7 - May 1 - Tuesday:**

**Massada - Ein Gedi - Qumran - Jerusalem**

After breakfast depart your hotel at the Dead Sea and drive to **Massada**. Ascend Massada by cable car. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the ramp, and the oldest synagogue in the world. Continue

along the shores of the Dead Sea to **Ein Gedi**, an oasis on the Dead Sea shore. Near the 200 meter high waterfall is a cave where David had his famous meeting with King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the reservation confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. On to **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. On your way to Jerusalem stop for a visit at **Genesis Land** that will include Abraham hospitality, camel ride and dinner. Drive to **Jerusalem** and enter the city as pilgrim. Overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

**Day 8 - May 2 - Wednesday:**

**Jerusalem**

In the morning ascend the **Mount of Olives** for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday Way** and descend to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Visit the famous **Church of All Nations**. Drive along the **Kidron Valley** and see the Tombs of Absalom, Zachary and James. Stand next to the excavation of the City of David and partake in the archeological sifting of the remains of the Temple Mount. Visit the **Last Supper Room** on Mt. Zion and **King David's Tomb**. You will also visit the **City of David** and the **Hezekiah Tunnel**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.



**Day 9 - May 3 - Thursday:**

**Jerusalem**

After breakfast drive to **Mt. Moriah**. Visit the **Western Wall**, last remnant of the second Jewish Temple during the time of Jesus. Walk up to the Temple site and view the **Dome of the Rock** and **El Aqsa Mosque**. Visit the **Cardo** (the Jewish Quarter), the **Rabbinical Tunnel** and the **Davidson Center** (Southern Wall). Walk to the **Pool of Bethesda** and **St. Anne's Church**, a fine example of Crusader architecture. Walk through the colorful Bazaar to the Jaffa Gate. In the afternoon drive to the **Ella Valley**, where David fought Goliath. Pass **Beit Shemash**. On your way back to Jerusalem stop for panoramic view of **Bethlehem**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

**Day 10 - May 4 - Friday:**

**Jerusalem - New City - Departure**

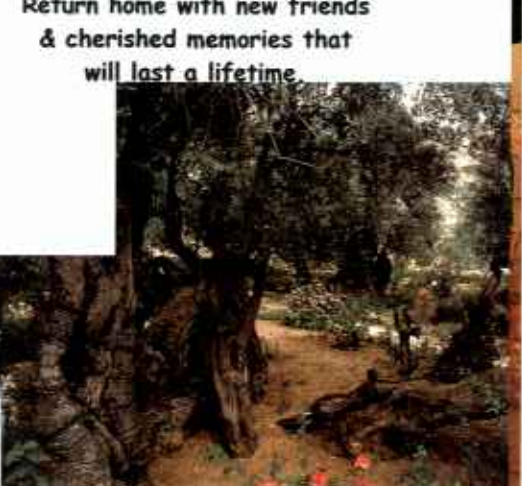
Visit the **Israel Museum**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are displayed and the **Holy Land walk-around model** of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the Second Temple period. Continue to the **Menorah**, across from the **Knesset** (Israeli parliament). On to **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Memorial, a visit you will never forget. End your visit with communion at the **Garden Tomb**. Farewell dinner. Late check out from the hotel and transfer to the airport.

**Day 11 - May 5 - Saturday:**

**Tel Aviv - USA**

Your flight back to the USA departs around midnight. Arrive the same day.

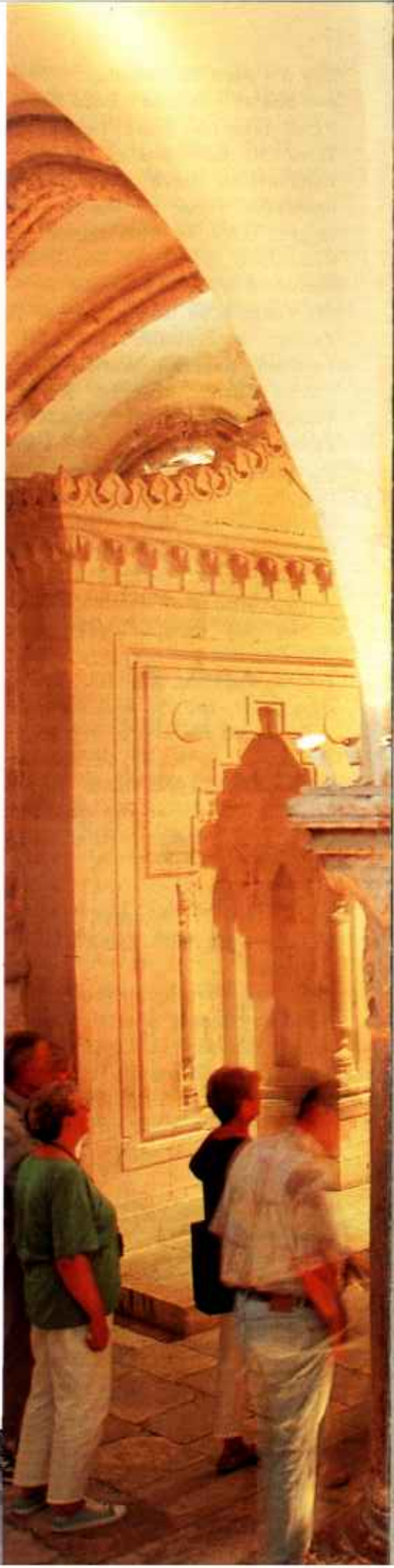
