

How to record an audio CD from the mp3 files

If you haven't done so, update your media player to the newest version your operating system can handle. For the purpose of this discussion, I will be talking about Windows Media Player version 10 and higher.

1. Download the mp3 file to a location you can find again.
2. Click on the mp3 file you downloaded – your media player should open and begin playing the file.
3. Click on the BURN link on the top row of the media player
4. Insert a blank CD into your CD burner
5. Click the BURN – NOW PLAYING link in the right column of the media player
6. Click the START BURN button at the bottom of the right column of the media player.
7. Screen image will change and Burning will start (this will happen whether or not you are listening to the file)
8. CD will eject when completed (this will now be in an audio format that you can play anywhere)
9. You may, at this point delete the mp3 file you downloaded.
